# **DONNA TICKELL**

Donna loved her sport but especially loved swimming. Donna together with her sister Nyrie, brother Lucas and parents Dennis and Rita joined the swimming club after moving to Strangways near Newstead.

Her parents took on roles as secretary, treasurer, president etc over a period of 10 years.

Donna had achieved her silver bar and was working towards earning her gold bar, which Nyrie had already earned.

Donna had swum in the Shell Championship Finals in Melbourne finishing 8<sup>th</sup>, with Freestyle being her favourite stroke. Donna's last competitive meet was here at Castlemaine in February 1990. The day after the meet she underwent an operation to remove a tumour from under her knee. Donna was elated to hear that the tumour was benign. So rehabilitation was next on the list.

Donna was recovering well and building up her strength, regularly riding her bike, until Thursday May 10<sup>th</sup> 1990 when she was struck by a car at Newstead and died. Donna was only 14 ½ years old.

The club started this event in memory of Donna in 1991 and see it as the highlight event of their swim meet.
